

Plan Progress

From May to October, the Pine River Watershed One Watershed One Plan has made steady progress. The Advisory Committee has met monthly to generate issues, prioritize issues, write a vision statement, and draft measurable goals.

In August, the Policy Committee approved the issue statements that were generated by the Advisory Committee. This fall, the Advisory Committee worked on drafting goals for the three main issue categories: surface water, ground water, and forestry/habitat. The next step is to work on a targeted implementation schedule, which are the actions for the plan. This section of the plan will detail what projects will be done and where, who will do them and how much they will cost.

The Draft Goals will be presented to the Policy Committee on January 9 for approval. Meeting summaries and approved Issue Statements can be found on the project website or from the contacts listed below.
