**Completion of this form does not constitute any implied approval or indication of compliance with applicable ordinances.** The Crow Wing County Land Use Ordinance and subsequent resolutions/clarification require that all wetlands within the boundaries of parcels to be divided by certificate of survey or plat be delineated. The Crow Wing County Land Use Ordinance requires minimum lot area standards for all new lots. This form is being signed because it is difficult to delineate wetlands or determine that no wetlands exist, due to lack of vegetation or frozen soils. If, when the wetland delineation is completed, it is determined that Crow Wing County Land Use Ordinance standards cannot be met, lot sizes and/or shapes must be adjusted to make the lots conform to Crow Wing County standards, or the lots will be declared unbuildable.

### Submittal Requirements:

- Any required survey during the winter should indicate the source of wetland information used, such as: National Wetlands Inventory, field crew approximation, delineator's approximation, aerial mapping, etc.
